PRIVACY NOTICE

We are committed to safeguarding your privacy. This notice sets out how we will treat your personal data.

Identity and contact details of the data controller

The mobile application named "Do It You Shelf" or "DIYS" (the "Application") is operated by Moët Hennessy South Africa Pty Ltd, a company having its registered address at 9th Floor, 22 Bree Street, Cape Town, South Africa, 8001, with company number 2015/380362/07, ("we") in its capacity of data controller for the purposes of applicable data protection laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) of 27 April 2016 (or any replacing law, act or regulation regarding Data Protection in force in your country).

Outside South Africa or unless otherwise indicated, the Moët Hennessy affiliate with which you are in contact or which is mentionned in the legal notices on the Application or in the Terms & Conditions of Use, whether in your country of residence or abroad, has the capacity of joint controller with Moët Hennessy South Africa Pty Ltd.What information do we collect?

Personal data is collected directly from you when you use the Application and our services or automatically when you access the Application.

We may process the following categories of personal data.

Information you provide to us:

- Information you may disclose when you contact us.

Information automatically collected:

How do you use my personal data?

We collect and process your personal data for the purposes listed below.

- Create an account on our Application;
- Any other services, current or future, related to the services we provide and listed in the relevant Terms
 & Conditions.

In order to comply with our legal obligations (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (c) GDPR):

• Processing in connection with legal claims and compliance purposes (including disclosure of such information in connection with legal processes or litigation).

Based on your prior consent (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (a) GDPR):

- Use of certain types of cookies. For more information regarding cookies, please read our <u>Cookies Notice</u>.
- Personalize the content of our Application.

Based on our legitimate interests (legal basis: Art. 6 (1) (f) GDPR) to ensure the security of our Application and its users and the compliance with our Terms & Conditions of Use and to communicate with you via "Contact Us" or similar forms.

When we ask you to supply us with personal data we will make it clear where there is a statutory or contractual (mandatory) requirement to provide personal data and the consequences of not providing the data (for example, that we will not be able to process your order).

Data transfers

Your rights

Under the GDPR you may have different data subject rights (Art. 15-18 and 20-21 GDPR). You also have rights to establish instructions for the management of your data after death, to object to some processing and, where we have asked for your consent to process your data, to withdraw this consent. In particular, you have rights to object to direct marketing at any time. Where we process your data because we have a legitimate interest in doing so (as explained above), you also have a right to object to this. These rights may be limited in some situations (for example, where we can demonstrate that we have a legal requirement to process your data).

COOKIES NOTICE

Cookies - what are they?

A "cookie" is a piece of information, like a tag, that is stored on your computer, tablet or phone when you visit a website. It can help identify your device (like your PC or mobile phone) whenever you visit that website.

Cookies are used by most major websites including MHCS's. To make the best use of our Application, on whichever device you use, you'll need to make sure your web browser is set to accept cookies.

What are cookies used for?

We use cookies and some other data stored on your device to:

- Give you a better online experience by displaying a customised editorial content based on what you have previously viewed.
- Allow you to set personal preferences (remember your login detail, choose a country and a language,).
- Protect your security.
- Measure and improve our service.
- Work with partners and measure the audience.

So what information is kept by the cookie?

The cookies we set

We use the following categories of cookies on our Application:

- Strictly Necessary Cookies: These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the Application and use its features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for such as remembering your login details cannot be provided.
- Performance Cookies: These cookies collect non-directly identifiable information on how people use our
 Application. For example, we use Google Analytics cookies to help us understand how customers arrive
 at our Application, browse or use our Application and highlight areas where we can improve, such as
 navigation, shopping experience and marketing campaigns. The data stored by these cookies never shows
 personal details from which your individual identity can be established.
- Functionality Cookies: These cookies remember choices you make such as the location you visit our
 Application from, language and search parameters such as size, colour or product line. These can then be
 ud to provide you with an experience more appropriate to your selections and to make the visits more
 tailored and pleasant. The information these cookies collect may be non-directly identifiable and they
 cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

How long do cookies stay on my computer?

Persistent cookies - these cookies are stored on your hard drive until you delete them or they reach their expiry date. These may, for example, be used to remember your preferences when you use the site. The lifespan of such cookies will not exceed twelve (12) months from date of consent.
